ORDER

Before the Court is the Plaintiff's Motion for Service of Notice of Garnishment via posting and U.S. Mail. In this matter a judgment was obtained and funds were garnished, but the Defendant has previously not been found or service was not otherwise perfected. At this time, the Plaintiff petitions the Court for permission to perfect service through posting and mailing notice to the Defendant. The Plaintiff has, through verified motion, affirmed to the Court that notice was provided to the Defendant contemporaneously with the service of the garnishment on the Garnishee. As such, Plaintiff's Motion for Service of Notice of Garnishment via posting and U.S. Mail is hereby GRANTED.

The Clerk's Office is directed to post on the clerk's website and in a conspicuous location within the courthouse a copy of the notice of garnishment along with this Order. The Clerk shall send by regular U.S. Mail a copy of these materials to the Defendant at Defendant's last known address. Lastly, the Clerk's Office shall assess the Plaintiff in this matter, or the moving party in the instance that it is not the Plaintiff, an additional fee as provided by section 6-6-394.1(6).

Once this matter has been posted for a minimum of four (4) continuous weeks, the Plaintiff or moving party may petition the Court for Condemnation. Any such petition shall be comprised of: (1) a verified motion that all requirements of this order have been accomplished, (2) a copy of the posting, and (3) a statement from the clerk's office attesting to the posting at the Courthouse, the posting on the website and verifying the dates of notice issued by U.S. Mailing.

No funds will be condemned for at least 5 days after the last date of the posting.
