## ORDER FOR SERVICE OF GARNISHMENT BY POSTING AND MAILING

The Court has considered the Plaintiff's Verified Motion for Permission To Serve Defendant Notice of Garnishment by Posting and Mailing, and hereby ORDERS, ADJUDGES, and DECREES that:

- 1. The Clerk of the Court shall post a copy of the notice of the garnishment, including a copy of the defendant's right to claim an exemption as provided in Rule 64A of the Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure, and this Order on its official website and in a designated conspicuous location within the courthouse for four continuous weeks.
- 2. The Clerk of the Court shall also send by regular U.S. Mail a copy of the posted notice of garnishment to the defendant at the defendant's last known address.
- 3. The fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) assessed to this motion shall be taxed to the Defendant.
- 4. The effective date of service shall be 28 days from the first date of the website posting.
- 5. This order shall apply only to the Process of Garnishment issued to Southern Deli Holdings, LLC.
